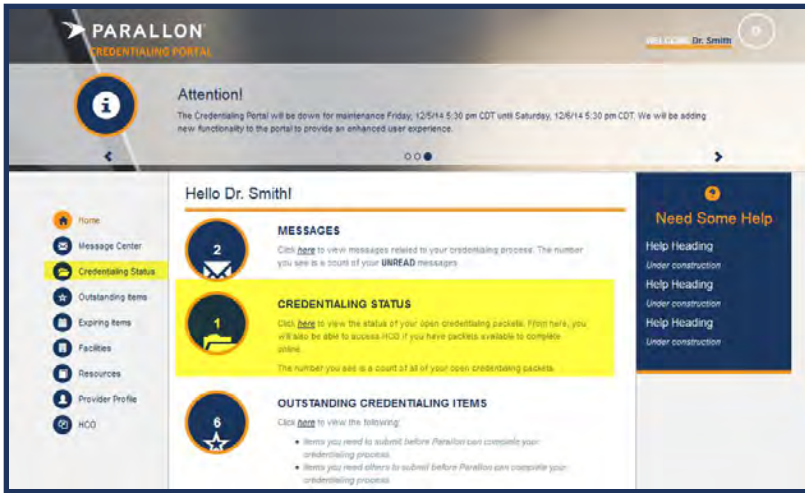
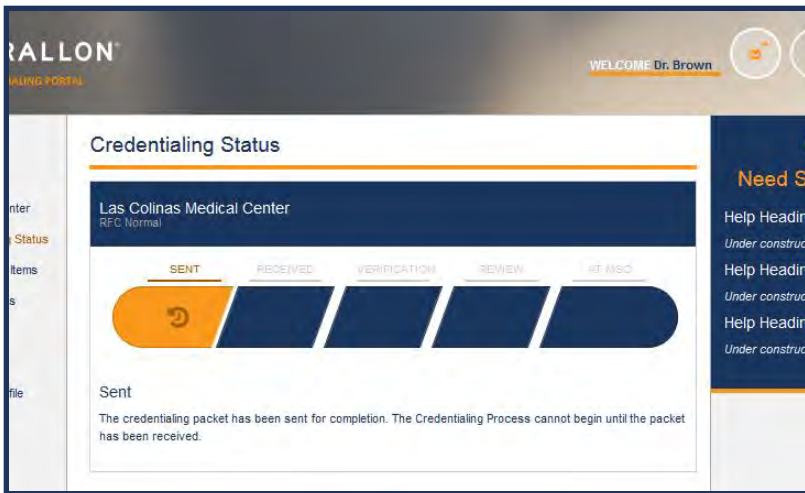


Credentialing Status

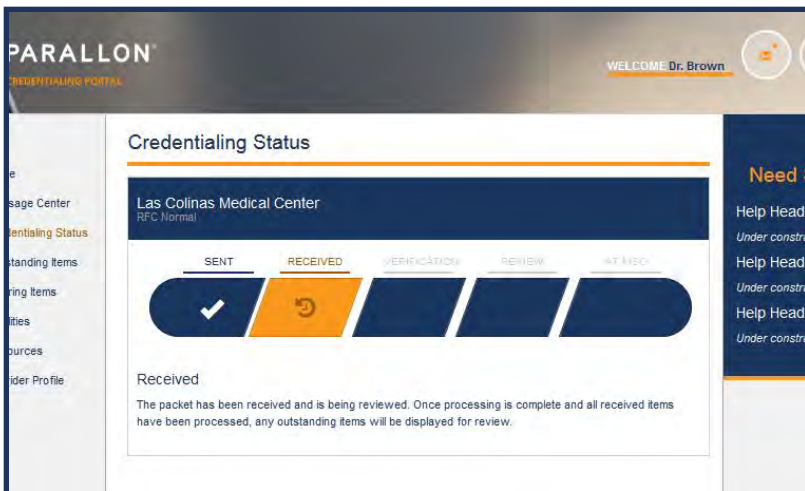
From the **Credentialing Portal** Home screen, you can access the **Credentialing Status** from the left menu navigation or from the center page.



As you move through each status of the **Credentialing Packet** process, you can follow your **packet**.



Notice the application is currently in **Sent** status, which means the credentialing packet has been sent for completion by the provider. Until the provider returns the packet, the Credentialing Process cannot begin.




Notice the application is currently in **Received** status, which means the packet has been received and is being reviewed.

Note: At this current phase no additional action is required by the provider, however, once all review /processing of received items are complete you will be able to access any items still outstanding.



Notice the application is currently in **Verification** status, which means the packet is currently in the verification process.

1. Click the **here link** to see all **outstanding items** needed to complete the credentialing process.



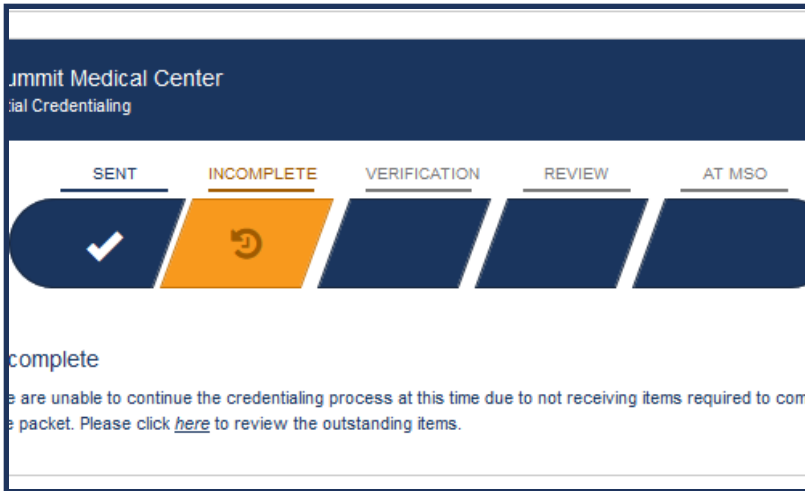

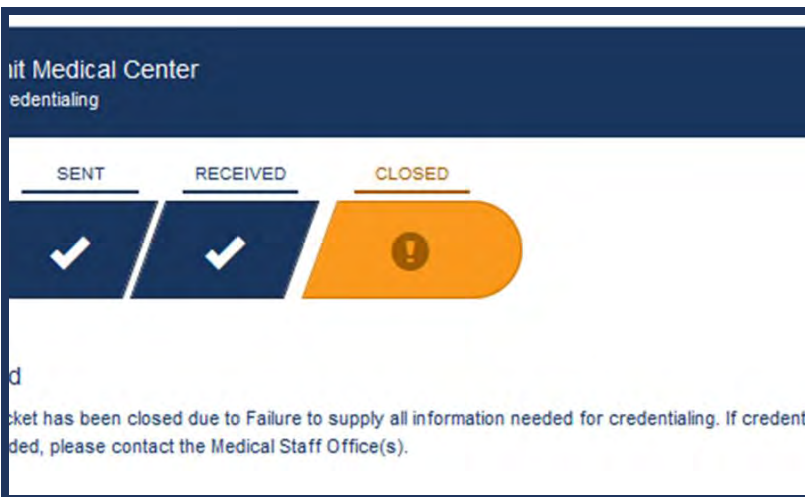

Credentialing Status



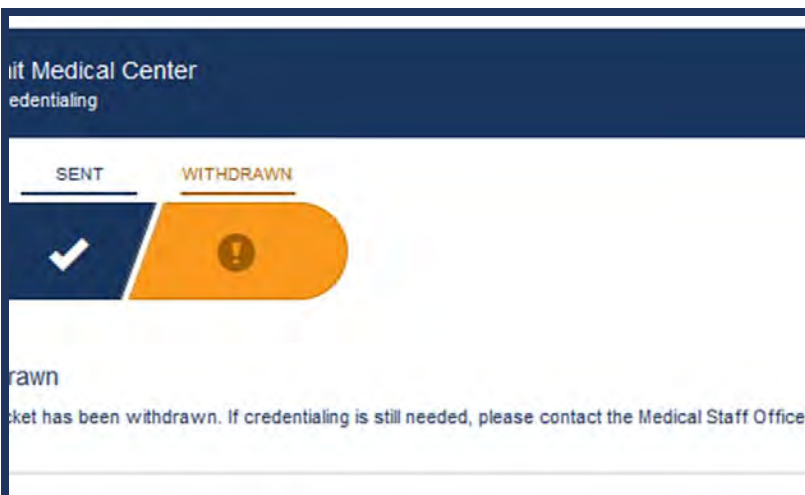
Notice the application is currently in **Incomplete** status, which means the packet is unable to continue in the Credentialing process because items required to complete the packet are missing.
