### SUMMARY OF TESTING METHODS AND KEY FINDINGS

Testing steps were provided to a subset of MyHealthONE users who agreed to participate in testing events utilizing their personal MyHealthONE accounts to access MyHealthONE via the web-based solution and/or the native mobile app. A survey was provided to each participant to capture the results of their testing, including identification of errors and narrative comments. Metrics were collected related to success and failure experienced by test participants based on the actions associated with 170.315(e)(1) View, Download, and Transmit. Results of user survey responses and findings were compiled and reviewed by MyHealthONE analyst for needed action items and potential improvements.
